Reporting in Horizon 2020 & Horizon Europe: Continuous Reporting and Periodic Report (90 + 30 min)

- Continuous reporting functionalities to submit deliverables, to report on progress in achieving milestones, to follow up on critical risks, ethics issues, publications, communications activities, and the answers to the questionnaire on horizontal issues.
- Periodic report: How to develop and what to include into the Technical report: Part A and Part B? How to complete on-line the Financial statement including the explanations on the use of resources?
- EU assessment of the Periodic report.

Review meeting (45 + 15 min)
